Hello parent and guardian of a special upper-secondary school student!

From next week until the Christmas break starts on 18 December, the majority of Kunskapsförbundet's operations will transition to distance learning.

At present, this will not affect your child's schooling. Special upper-secondary school is one of the operations where teaching will be conducted as usual – this decision is based on an assessment of the Public Health Agency of Sweden taking into account on your child's health and need for (and right to) education.

During the autumn we have taken various measures to try to reduce congestion and avoid larger gatherings, for example by eating meals in the individual classrooms. When the number of other students at the school decreases, the school will also have better opportunities to use more premises and increase distances even further.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the guidelines that we all need to follow:

- Stay at home if you have the slightest symptom. Get tested.
- Wash your hands.
- Keep your distance!
- Don't take public transport unless you absolutely have to.
- Avoid larger social gatherings

If any student comes to school with cold-like symptoms or falls ill during the day, you will be contacted and your child will be sent home. It is important that we adhere to these directives so that we minimise the risk of contagion at the school.

If someone at home has tested positive for COVID-19, everyone in the family should stay at home, even if she/he does not have symptoms, for at least 7 days after the positive test result. You must also follow the instructions of the infectious disease doctor. This is a new guideline from which pre-school, primary school and special school pupils and upper-secondary school students were previously excluded, but starting today it also applies to them.

Let us hope the measures we are implementing now will make matters easier in the spring, and that we will soon be able to return to normal life.

We must support all young people and children, help them stick to the rules that are in place, and remind each other that this, too, shall pass.
